Position Title: Psychiatrist (Part Time, 1 Day a Week)

Job Summary:

The Psychiatrist provides mental health clinical services to adults, children and their families with mental health issues, including psychiatric diagnosis, prescription writing, and psychotherapy as part of a full service treatment team. Services may include: evaluation, assessment, crisis intervention, plans development, case management, therapy, after-care planning and rehabilitation planning.

Job Qualifications:

- Doctorates degree in Medicine or Osteopathy from an accredited institution. 4+ years of clinical experience in a clinic environment with completion of psychiatric residency.
- Hold & maintain current, valid & unrestricted professional license to practice and prescribe (DEA License) in the State of California. Must meet necessary requirements for malpractice and general liability insurance.
- Must successfully complete the provider credentialing process in accordance with National Accreditation standards.
- Knowledge of theory and treatment practices of intrapsychic, interpersonal and social problems; community mental health, and alcohol and other drug abuse interventions.
- Excellent interpersonal, verbal and written skills.
- Able to communicate effectively with staff, community and the general public.
- Understanding of California mandated reporting laws.
- Knowledge of general mental health services and California State Rehabilitation Mental Health Option services is helpful.
- Knowledge of & ability to relate to the American Indian community and other minority populations.
- Dedication and commitment to providing care in underserved and underrepresented communities.
- Understands and promotes the mission, vision and values of the health center both in the work place and in the community.
