- Parenting education and support featuring the Family Spirit Model
- Home Safety and child development screening
- Community Resources
- Breastfeeding/prenatal education and support
- Emergency diapers up to 2x within 6 months
- Car seat safety and injury prevention
- Crisis intervention and CPS advocacy

To Qualify:

- Be American Indian/Alaska Native (self-identified accepted)
- Have children under 5 years old (special circumstances are considered)
- Be registered, active patients with SNAHC
- Live in Sacramento County
- Qualify for Medi-Cal
- · Willing to meeting with a home visitor on a consistent basis.
- Crisis intervention and CPS advocacy (if needed)
